

ALCOHOL INKS SUPPLY LIST

Plastic sheet to cover table. A small plexiglass or coroplast surface to work on.(you can use a small sheet of extra plastic.

Paper towel

91% isopropyl alcohol. (Available at Costco in 4 bottle packs)

Blending solution(optional)

Latex gloves (to protect your hands from staining)(hand sanitizer to remove stains)

A variety of small plastic containers such as shot glasses(available at the dollar stores)

Pipettes(optional)

Small brushes to move the alcohol ink, cosmetic pads or sponges, Q tips,

Manipulation tools to move the alcohol ink(drinking straws with bendable ends, low heat blow dryer, alcohol ink blower,

Small spray bottle available from art stores

Surfaces to create your masterpiece. I will be mainly using Yupo paper, mostly white with possible one black sheet. I will also demonstrate on white ceramic tiles.

Alcohol Ink in a variety of Colors. I mainly use Pinata but Copic Inks and Ranger are also good choices.

Optional Alcohol ink markers for finer control.

UPO Paper	Ceramic Tile
Ink stains the paper	Ink can be lifted back to white
Ink spreads further	Ink spreads less
Can seal with Krylon Kamar	Must seal with Krylon Kamar
