APPROACHES TO ACRYLIC LANDSCAPE PAINTING with Brian Buckrell



This three day acrylic workshop will expose students to strong fundamentals for planning and developing an acrylic landscape painting. It is designed for the serious beginner (with acrylic experience) to the intermediate painter interested in strengthening approaches to planning interpreting the landscape. A well planned foundation is the basis on which a more intuitive (loose) finish is accomplished.

We will review/discuss the fundamental principles of colour, value, form and composition that we will be applying in our paintings. For the first two days we will paint together from the provided references. We will plan using shape and value sketches leading to best compositional choices.. We will develop the paintings together.

The final day students will work under supervision from their own reference using the principles developed in days one and two. We will review the use of software to enhance photos for stronger references. Lots of learning; lots of fun.
