SUPPLY LIST – BEGINNER COLLAGE

Golden Fluid Acrylic Paints - Joyce's favourites but bring what you have
Titanium White
*Yellow Ocher
Quinacridone Burnt Orange
Yellow

French Ultramarine Blue
Cadmium Red
*Prussian Blue
*Burnt Umber

* are the colours that we will use for the majority of the first day painting

The 1 oz size bottle will last you a long time.

2 - 30 Sheet Package of White Tissue Paper
Polymer medium, gloss Optional - This is used if you like the gloss surface finish

Polymer Mat Medium
Flexible Spackle Compound or Molding Paste
Heavy Gel medium

Substrates: cradled wood panels preferred, but stretched canvas or canvas boards are OK
2 - 9 X 12 or 11X14

Unprimed wood panels should be primed with gesso before class.

Brushes suitable for acrylic - Some of Joyce's favourite brushes are found in the Dollar Store
Joyce uses 3/4 inch flat, a #6 round, and a small detail brush and a package of dollar store brushes (5 in a pkg) acrylic

Items that make good stamping materials - Do not worry about getting all the items but these are items that make good patterns on tissue. Elastics (make your own brush), old toothbrush, bubble wrap, old rolling pin, lace, burlap, buttons, bath sponges, cheese cloth, adhesive foam pieces from the dollar store, large leaves, anything that you can make an Imprint of, and if you are a stamper you can use stamps as well

The usual stuff - hair dryer, palette knives, paper towels, ruler, scissors, pencil, palette, spray water bottle (old hair spray bottles are the best)

Supplied

1 Blue Sponge and a variety of printing materials
