SUPPLY LIST – BEGINNER ACRYLIC II

- Acrylic Paint. Most demonstrations will be done with either liquid acrylics or full body acrylics.

Colors;

Titanium white - bigger bottle or tube

Ivory Black

Burnt Sienna

Yellow ochre

Yellow- primary yellow or diarylide yellow

Red- Quinacridone Red or Naphthol red

Blue- Cobalt Blue and ultramarine blue

Quinacridone magenta

- Paper towel/Rags
- Regular gel medium
- Semi-gloss medium
- Painting Grounds Acrylics can be painting on almost anything. For this class I recommend you get masonite panels or cheaper canvas panels in the following sizes.....8"x10" (6)
- Sketch book
- Brushes: Cheaper brushes are totally acceptable. A variety of sizes. Round and Flat. Make sure you have at least a 1 inch flat and a 6 and 8 round.
- Pad of Palette paper. For a palette I like a container that has a sealable lid on it. Acrylic paints dry quickly so it is important to use a palette that is closable. My palette is one with a sponge insert in the center which absorbs water and a piece of palette paper on top . Wells for the paint surround the center. The lid covers the paint when not in use. I have also used long shallow tupperware containers as a palette.

- Pencil

- Eraser

- Small spray bottle

- Colour wheel
