Supply List

Watercolor paper 140 lb. cold press and at least one sheet of 300lb. coldpress and one sheet of 140 hot press. Two different sizes of coroplast one for larger 1/2 sheets of watercolor paper and ones for 1/4 sheets or smaller. (These may be purchased at and home hardware store in larger sheets and cut with a utility knife to the desired size.)

Sketch Book, pencils 2H, HB, Kneadable eraser, Masking Fluid, Masking Tape, exacto or utility Knife

Watercolors and palette. While there are a large number of colors available I suggest you have a warm and cool of each color.
