Brushes

2 flat brushes 1 inch and ½ inch

2 round brushes #6 and #9

2 angle brushes ½ inch and 1 Inch

1 rigger brush #2 palette knife if you like texture.

Supply List Liquid Acrylics Paint. For beginning painters we will use the liquid acrylics. Intermediates may use what they like except full body acrylics as at this point they have too much bulk and texture.

Brushes: I usually use an assortment of brushes and sizes

Liquin if you use it. Neutral Thin (EcoHouse) 4 Canvasses 18" x 24"(gesso primed)

Sketchbook Pencil Kneadable eraser pallet cloths or paper towel.

Small spray bottle Black Felt pen fine tip Paper Towel Rubber gloves if you prefer.

Palette for acrylics(one that has a top you can close to prevent the paint from drying out) Try not to get one too small. You need enough room to mix the paint.

Reference material

There are a number of surfaces you can use. The easiest is to buy less expensive canvases - 18"x24" is less intimidating at this point. 4 Canvases or extras if you're fast.
