### SUPPLY LIST

#### OIL/ ACRYLIC PAINTS

- Titanium White (big tube!!!)
- Naples Yellow Lt.
- Lemon/Hansa Yellow
- Cadmium Yellow Med.
- · Cadmium Red Med.
- Yellow Ochre / Oxide Yellow (acrylics)
- Alizarin Crimson
- Venetian Red / Oxide Red (acrylics)
- Dioxane Purple
- Phthalo Blue
- Ultramarine Blue
- Cerulean Blue hue
- Phthalo Green
- Burnt Umber
- Ivory Black/ Mars Black (acrylics)

If you use oil paints, make sure to have a basic set of acrylic paints to prime your canvases.

## **PALETTE KNIVES**

□ Various sizes and shapes; the "must" palette knife is of diamond shape 1.5" – 2"

#### **BRUSHES**

- Various size bristle brushes: minimum ½" filbert and ¾" flat
- Various size synthetic brushes (med. soft): minimum one 1" flat, a pointed one for sketching and details),  $\frac{1}{2}$ " and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " filberts

#### **MEDIUM**

- Oils: Cold Wax medium (any brand) and Liquin or Linseed Oil
- Acrylics: modeling paste or acrylic gel (gloss and heavy or regular)

## **CANVAS or BOARD**

• Minimum three canvases or Masonite/birch boards: size - up to the student.

## **OTHER MATERIALS**

- A roll of paper towels
- Paint palette
- Spray bottle (acrylics)
- For oils: min. 250 ml. GAMSOL: Gamblin's odorless mineral spirits (oils).
- For acrylics: a few buckets for water
